Transfer Protocol for Frankston Independent School District

On April 1, Frankston ISD began accepting transfers for 2018-2019 school year. Currently enrolled students are required to reapply for the upcoming school year. The deadline for submitting transfer applications is May 31st. Failure to submit a completed application by the deadline will lead to an automatic transfer denial. Following the deadline, applications will be reviewed by the Frankston ISD Transfer Committee and final decisions made by the school principal by June 30th. Students who do not meet the minimum academic and behavioral criteria identified below will not be considered for enrollment and incomplete applications will be denied.

- No more than 5 unexcused absences (3 unexcused tardies equals 1 unexcused absence)
- No DAEP placements
- No more than 2 level 1 conduct offenses (as defined by the FISD Student Code of Conduct)
- No Level 2 offenses (as defined by the FISD Student Code of Conduct)
- No more than ½ credit lost due to course failure or attendance in previous school year (High School)
- Course averages in Reading and Math must be at least a 70 (ES and MS)
- Must have made minimum passing score on Math and Reading STAAR/EOC (ALL campuses)

If you do not agree with the decision of the Transfer Committee, a Transfer Appeal may be filed with the campus principal. During the appeal, the student must remain enrolled in their home campus until a final decision on the appeal is made.
