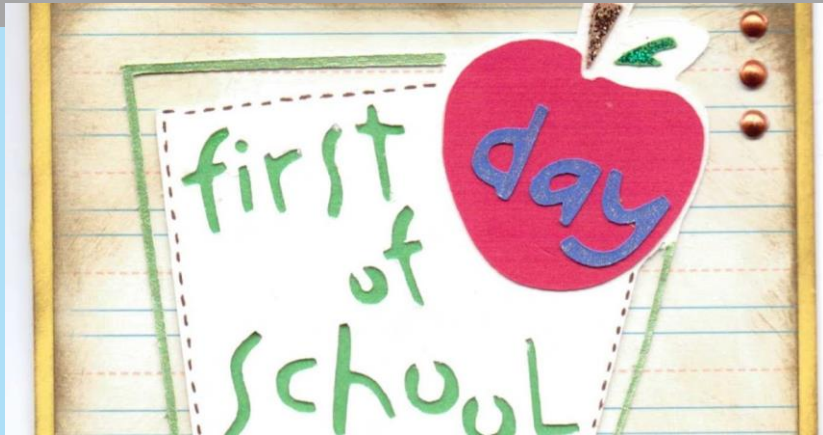

# 2020-2021 School Year

## State Funding

- ~Transition Window (4 weeks)
- ~Synchronous Instruction
- ~Asynchronous Instruction
- ~Hold-Harmless ADA-1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Six Weeks (18-19 school year)



## Federal Funding

- ~No delays in funding at this point
- ~All 2019-2020 payments have been received

**Concern: 13 students have withdrawn to Home School (\$6160/student)**





# 2020-2021 School Year

## Preparation for Opening (Staff)



- ~ **Employee self-screenings**
- ~ **Hand sanitizer at entrances and every classroom**
- ~ **Face coverings for all staff (Face shields and/or masks)**
- ~ **Social Distancing (6 feet at all times)**
- ~ **More frequent cleaning, sanitizing, & disinfecting**
- ~ **Sneeze Guards for all secretaries/receptionists**

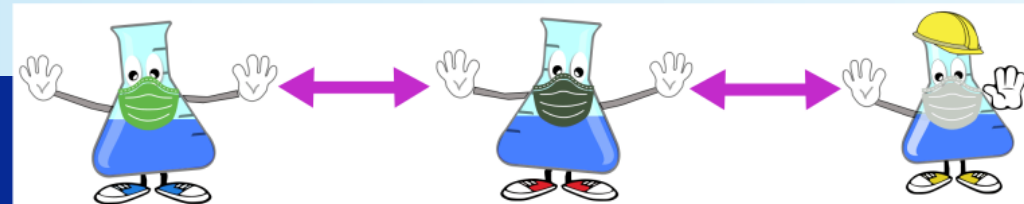


# 2020-2021 School Year

## Preparation for Opening (Students)

- ~Temp checks for all students at entry doors
- ~Hand sanitizer at entrances and every classroom
- ~Face coverings for all students
- ~Social Distancing (6 feet at all times)
- ~Directional Signs (floors and walls)
- ~Eating in small groups (classrooms, common areas, etc.)
- ~More frequent cleaning, sanitizing, & disinfecting
- ~Touchless water fountains

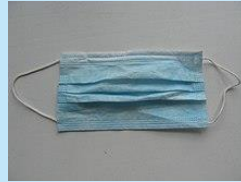
